Join a creative team of educators and scientists to bring vital programs to the next generation of young women in science, building a learning community of youth as they develop their identities as young scientists and engineers.

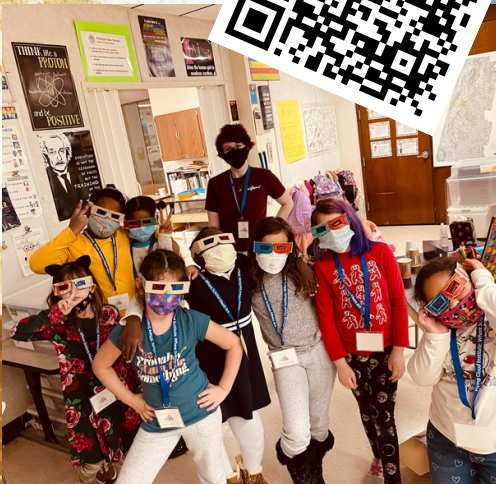
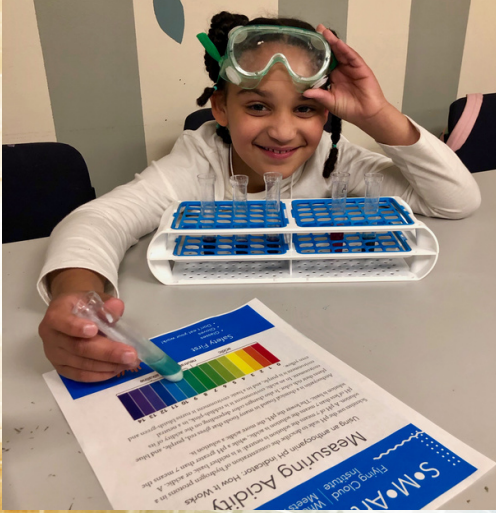

## Job Responsibilities

- Run Girls Science Club (GSC) after school programs for girls age 9-11: create an intentional learning community of participants; support and guide high school mentors in planning and implementing activities; organize culminating showcases for caregivers and peers
- Participate in Flying Cloud Institute staff meetings and trainings, attend weekly supervision meetings with the Young Women In Science Director

- Previous experience working with young people
- Ability to adapt to a changing environment and handle multiple priorities
- Excellent writing and analytical skills
- Experience using G-suite and Excel a plus
